

SHOE BOX GIFTS FOR CHILDREN IN MEXICO

Suggested Gifts

Small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, harmonicas, yoyos, ball and jacks, Slinky, Etch-A-Sketch, things that light up and/or make noise, marbles, pacifiers, blankets, bottles, infant's clothes, baby toys, pens, pencils, sharpeners, crayons, markers, stamps and ink pad sets, coloring books, writing pads, paper, calculators, toothbrushes, toothpaste, combs, brush, washcloths, lotion, shampoo, soap (in plastic bag), candy (nothing that melts), lollipops, mints, gum, sunglasses, flashlights, ball caps, socks, toy jewelry sets, hair clips
Add batteries if needed.

DO NOT include toy guns, knives, or other war related items, chocolate, or perishables.

INSTRUCTIONS

Please mark the gift whether for a boy, girl, or either. Mark what age group (infants up to 12 months, 1-2, 3-5, 6-10, 11-14). Please only use shoe boxes or plastic boxes of the same size. This makes it easier to handle. The box can be wrapped with Christmas paper. Please wrap the lid separately and put a thick rubber band around the box and lid. Mexican Customs officials may look in the boxes. Due to the cost of transportation and other expenses, **please enclose \$2** in an envelope clearly visible inside each box.. DirectLine Ministry needs to receive the shoe boxes by **November 21**.
